



Orton-Gillingham Classroom Educator 30-Hour Online Course

Dates : September 25-27 and Oct 16-18

- Fridays 3:00-6:00
- Saturdays and Sundays 9:00-3:00

This 30 hour course meets the requirements for the Orton-Gillingham Classroom Educator designation with the Academy of Orton Gillingham Practitioners and Educators (AOGPE). It is the first step in preparing teachers to use the OG approach in the classroom setting and allows teachers to use direct instruction to bring a multi-sensory, structured, and linguistic phonics-based approach into the mainstream and small-group classroom. The curriculum will include: dyslexia and reading disorders; the rationale of the OG approach; handwriting; phonological awareness, phonics, syllable division patterns, and spelling; elements of multisensory instruction, diagnostic-prescriptive teaching, and lesson planning; and AOGPE membership structure and requirements. Instruction includes workshops, simulations, and small group work. All materials are provided. The course will be accessed live through Zoom.

Orton-Gillingham Associate 30-Hour Online Course

Dates: August 17-21 (8:30-4:00) Cost: \$1500, plus \$95.00 materials fee

It is the second 30-hr course for preparing teachers to use the OG approach in the classroom setting and allows teachers to use direct instruction to bring a multi-sensory, structured, and linguistic phonics-based approach into the mainstream and small-group classroom. The curriculum will include: AOGPE membership structure and practicum requirements, lesson planning, tests and measurements for diagnosing dyslexia, morphology, vocabulary, fluency, comprehension and written expression. Instruction includes workshops, simulations, and small group work. All materials provided/ The course will be accessed live through Zoom.

Please note, in addition to these courses, a practicum is required for the completion of requirements for both Classroom Educator and the Associate Level of certification, and is required for an individual to represent themselves as Orton-Gillingham trained.
